Duncan Pow is a Scottish actor best known in his role in Sky One's Dream Team, as Liam Mackay the captain of Harchester United F.C.

After Dream Team finished for good he spent 6 months auditioning for parts before he finally got the part of controversial character Linden Cullen in BBC One's Holby City in 2007. He started filming in September and had his first appearance in January 2008 in the episode "Stolen" (S10.E14)

Duncan was born in Scotland and moved to the small medieval city of Wells in Somerset when he was 12. He attended Wells Blue School. After leaving school he studied Maths at Edinburgh University and Multimedia Technology at Leeds Metropolitan University where he got a first class honours degree.

Duncan's other jobs included: ticket collector at Wookey Hole Caves Yoghurt Packing, Plastics factory, Barman, Kitchen Hand, Forklift Truck Operator, DJ, Editor, Cameraman, Pan cleaner, Meat factory, Journalist, Script Editor for financial news programmes, and a website designer.

Duncan is a keen supporter of children's cancer charity, CLIC Sargent having had first hand experience of the work the charity does. His cousin, Westley Hendry, lost his battle with cancer in 2006 at the age of just 16. The family were supported by CLIC Sargent and Duncan has become an active supporter of the cause. He recently won a special edition of the BBC quiz show the Weakest Link and raised £8,600 for the charity.
